



## MeTime Parent FAQ

### What is MeTime Member Access?

MeTime Member Access is a monthly membership that allows families to lock in our 2025 frozen hourly rates, receive one free hour of childcare each week, and enjoy additional member benefits.

### How much does the membership cost?

The membership is \$20 per month beginning January 2026.

### What are the 2025 frozen member rates?

Infants under 12 months are \$16 per hour, children 12–23 months are \$13 per hour, children ages 2–12 are \$12 per hour, and siblings are \$6 per hour.

### What benefits are included with membership?

Members receive one free hour of childcare per week, free snacks at scheduled snack times, and access to member-only discounts and rewards.

### What is Non-Member Access?

Non-Member Access allows families to use MeTime without a membership and pay standard non-member rates.

### What are the non-member hourly rates?

Non-member rates are \$20 per hour for the youngest child and \$15 per hour for each sibling.

### Is there a registration fee for non-members?

Yes. There is an annual registration fee of \$45 each new year.

### Do non-members receive a free weekly hour?

No. The free weekly hour is a benefit available only to members.

### Are snacks included for non-members?

No. Snacks are included for members only during scheduled snack times.

### How do I decide which option is best for my family?
